BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED, this project shall be a "Capital Reserve" project and the Board of Education is NOT seeking State funding but will fund the Project through the District's Reserve Account.

2.3 To approve a contract with the Gillepsie Group, an approved ESCNJ Co-op contracted vendor, to remove old carpet and abatement of asbestos tiles and replace with new LVT flooring at the Taylor Street School in the amount of \$60,284.76.
