DRESS FOR THE WEATHER

Freezing temperatures are upon us. Please make sure children are wearing their coats, gloves and hats when coming to school. If you need assistance in providing these items, please contact the school nurse.

FROM THE HEALTH OFFICE

Students Entering Sixth Grade... The State of New Jersey now requires all students born on or after January 1, 1997 and entering grade six to receive a booster dose of diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis vaccine (Tdap) as well as one dose of meningococcal vaccine. All students are required to have both immunizations before September 1, 2022 in order to enter sixth grade. Please provide the health office with documentation as soon as they are received.

Kindergarten Immunizations... In accordance with N.J.A.C. 8:57-4, children entering kindergarten must have a total of 4 doses of DTAP, with one dose after the 4th birthday or any 5 doses, a total of 3 doses of IPV (Polio), with one dose after the 4th birthday or any 4 doses, 2 doses of MMR, 1 dose of Varicella (Chickenpox) after 1st birthday, and 3 doses of Hepatitis B. Please provide the health office with documentation as soon as they are received. Visit this link for further information -
