FROM THE HEALTH OFFICE

The New Jersey State Department of Education and the Department of Health and Senior Services strongly recommend that students obtain a physical examination by your healthcare provider/private physician at least once during each of the following student's developmental stages: Early childhood - preschool through grade three, Pre-adolescence - grades four through six, and Adolescence - grade seven through twelve. If you have any questions, please contact the Health Office at your child's school.

Students Entering Sixth Grade... The State of New Jersey now requires <u>all students born on or after January 1, 1997</u> and entering grade six to receive a booster dose of diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis vaccine (Tdap) as well as one dose of meningococcal vaccine. All students are required to have both immunizations before September 1, 2024 in order to enter sixth grade. Please provide the health office with documentation as soon as they are received.

Kindergarten Immunizations... In accordance with N.J.A.C. 8:57-4, children entering kindergarten must have a total of 4 doses of DTAP, with one dose after the 4th birthday or any 5 doses, a total of 3 doses of IPV (Polio), with one dose after the 4th birthday or any 4 doses, 2 doses of MMR, 1 dose of Varicella (Chickenpox) after 1st birthday, and 3 doses of Hepatitis B.
